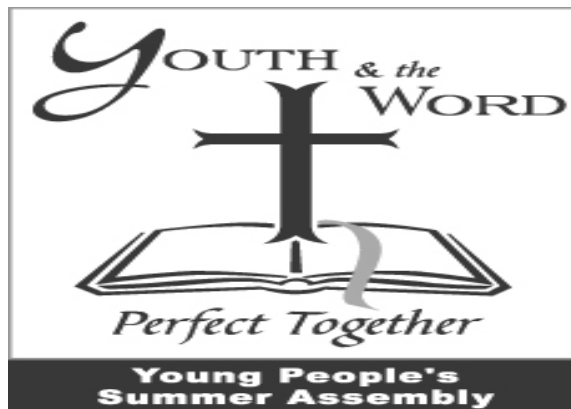

## CRITERIA FOR ATTENDANCE

- ALL STUDENTS MUST BE AGE 14 OR OLDER AND BE IN HIGH SCHOOL OR ABOUT TO ENTER HIGH SCHOOL TO BE ACCEPTED.
- YOUNG PERSONS WHO HAVE ALREADY SHOWN LEADERSHIP STRENGTHS AND ARE MATURE ENOUGH TO CONDUCT THEMSELVES IN A SUITABLE MANNER AWAY FROM HOME.
- DO NOT SEND PROBLEM YOUTH.
- THE PASTOR MUST SIGN THE APPLICATIONS; ALSO THE YOUTH DIRECTOR, SUPERINTENDENT OR OTHER AUTHORIZED PERSONS. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO STAY ON CAMPUS FOR THE ENTIRE WEEK. EACH CHURCH IS LIMITED TO 4 STUDENTS. (CONTACT THE DIRECTOR IF ADDITIONAL STUDENTS WISH TO ATTEND)
- ALL FIRST YEAR STUDENTS MUST SUBMIT AN ESSAY AND BE INTERVIEWED BY THE DIRECTOR OF SUMMER ASSEMBLY AND REPRESENTATIVES. THE ESSAY MUST BE TYPED HAVING A MINIMUM OF 100 WORDS. THE ESSAY SHOULD INDICATE WHY THE STUDENT WISHES TO ATTEND SUMMER ASSEMBLY. THEY MUST INCLUDE WHAT THEY FEEL THEY WILL GAIN FROM THE EXPERIENCE. THE ESSAY MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION AND INITIAL DEPOSIT. A PARENT MEETING FOR ALL NEW STUDENTS IS REQUIRED
- ALL STUDENTS MUST MEET ALL REQUIREMENTS TO ATTEND.
